Meeting times

We meet at the Scout Hut in Queensbury during term time only, from 6.15pm to 7.30pm on a Wednesday. Please do not drop your child off before 6.15pm as we need time to prepare for the evening's activities.

Uniform

When your child first comes to Beavers they can wear their own clothes.

Once your child has attended Beavers for a few weeks and they have decided that they wish to join they will need a uniform. We cannot invest them without uniform (Beaver Scout jumper and navy blue scout activity trousers). Beaver polo shirts are optional but most of our beavers do wear them. A list of suppliers is given on the reverse of this note (prices vary between suppliers).

Initial badges and neckerchief are bought from us (total cost £6.50) when Beavers are invested; they cannot be invested until they have a uniform.

We also ask that black shoes are worn when on parade.

Subs

Subs are £12 per month and should be paid on the first Wednesday of every month. Cheques should be made payable to 'Queensbury Beaver Colony'. Payment can also be made by standing order to reach our account by the 10th of the month.

Beaver Scout Promise

When Beavers are invested, they are asked to recite the Beaver Scout Promise:

to be kind and helpful
and to love God.
